## **THERE'S STILL TIME TO BE VACCINATED AGAINST H1N1 INFLUENZA**

**(Broward County, Florida)** – Broward County Health Department encourages **ALL** persons to get vaccinated against H1N1 Influenza and reminds parents and guardians to get children, 6 months to 10 years of age, their second dose of the H1N1 vaccine.

To prevent the spread of Influenza and other respiratory illnesses:

- Take the time to get vaccinated against Seasonal and H1N1 Influenza.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use alcohol-based hand cleaners.
- Keep your hands away from your face.
- Stay home if you are sick for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone without the use of fever reducing medicine.
- See your healthcare provider if you are sick.
- Take antiviral medicine if recommended.
